

NCISAA ATHLETIC TRANSFER OF ELIGIBILITY FORM

NCISAA rules require an Transfer of Eligibility form to be completed before a student transferring from one NCISAA school to another NCISAA school, during the school year, may compete in interscholastic athletics. Students who transfer from one NCISAA school to another must meet the terms of the NCISAA Athletic Recruitment Policy.

Section A must be completed by the head of the school from which a student is transferring (exit school) and Section B by the head of the school to which the student is transferring (entrance school). When section A is completed by the exit school, the form should be sent to the entrance school and retained in the student's file. Questions should be directed to the NCISAA office.
